





# Press Release - 02<sup>nd</sup> October 2022

Regarding the violent incident disrupting the "International YOGA Day" event held during the early hours of 21st June 2022 in Male Football Stadium, the Prosecutor General has filed charges against the below named individuals for committing acts of terror against the participants of the event and obstructing the law enforcement officers at the scene-

Under Section 8 of Act no. 32/2015 (Anti-terrorism Act):

Charge: Encouraging to commit an act of terrorism Possible Penalty: 10 to 15 Years – Imprisonment

Charge: Committing an act of terrorism

Charge: Committing assault and battery with dangerous weapon

Possible Penalty: 07 to 10 Years - Imprisonment

Under Section 9 of Act no. 17/2010 (Act on Prohibiting Threatening and Possession of Dangerous Weapons and Sharp Objects):

Charge: Attempted battery with dangerous weapon
